# Show Rules

## The following rules apply:

1. A junior must be under the age of 19 on January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.
2. All wether entries are \$20.00 per animal per show. Early entries are suggested to limit same day registration delays. There will be a service charge of \$30.00 for NSF checks. If you have fees due from a previous show, you will not be allowed to show until all fees are paid. No email or phone entries accepted. Mailing address is listed on the entry form.
3. Pen fees are \$5.00 per pen. Pen size is 5 x 6. Pen availability will be on a first come basis.
4. All animals must be in place and entry forms checked in with the show secretary by 8:30 AM the day of the show.
5. All animals must be healthy. No visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases will be allowed. Any unhealthy or questionable animals will be checked by the veterinarian at the owner's expense.
6. All of out of state animals must have health papers and proper tests required by the state of Ohio. Health papers must be dated within 30 days of the show. All out of state exhibitors must be at the fairgrounds by 8:30 a.m. on the day of the show with health papers checked in or they will not be permitted to show and forfeit all entry fees. No health papers are required for Ohio goats.
7. All goats must comply with the Ohio scrapie rules. Ohio State Vet: 614-469-5602.
8. The Ross County Boer Goat Association or the Ross County Fairgrounds will not be held responsible for loss, damage, or accidents. Any person or family not acting in an honorable manner will be required to leave immediately and will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the show. There will be no alcohol or drugs allowed on the fairgrounds.
9. Wether Sires, Wether Dams and Wethers will be weighed in at check-in time and will be divided as equally as possible into classes determined by weight. Wether Sires and Wether Dams that have lost any kid teeth will show in the Sr. class and will not be weighed.
10. The scales for Wether Sires, Wether Dams and Wethers will be open from 7:00-8:30 a.m. on the morning of the show. They will close promptly at 8:30 a.m. (or when all goats in line have been weighed). If you are not in line to be weighed by 8:30 a.m., you will not be weighed – NO exceptions.
11. Payouts for the Wether Show as well as the Wether Sire and Wether Dam Shows will be determined by the number of pre-entered entries and are subject to change. NOTE: Grand Champion Market Goat will be a guaranteed payout of \$300.00 and Reserve \$150.00 and will receive banners.
12. Wethers must still have their milk teeth.
13. Wether Sires, Wether Dams and Wethers must be slick shorn to an even length from the knees and hocks up excluding the head and tail switch. No blocking will be permitted and will be grounds for refused entry into the ring.
14. Refer to the MWGS website [www.midwestwgs.com](http://www.midwestwgs.com) for official rules about showmanship and membership.

NOTE: Youth must be a member to the Midwest Wether Goat Series in order to accumulate points for the awards at the final show at the Ohio State Fair in July. Membership is \$20 and more information can be found on their website or at a show. Points are only accumulated with Showmanship and the Wether Show and not with the Wether Sires and Wether Dams. Membership is not required to be able to show wethers.

# Open Wether Sires and Wether Dams

1. Open to all exhibitors.
2. No registration papers are required for the Wether Sire and Wether Dam classes.
3. There will be two divisions; buck and does.
4. All entries must be slick shorn to 3/8 inch or less (equivalent to Lister Cover Code blade).
5. Weigh-in for Wether Sires and Wether Dams will take place from 7-8:30 a.m. and will be divided as equally as possible into classes determined by weight. Wether Sires and Wether Dams that have lost any kid teeth will show in the Sr. class and will not be weighed.
6. Wether Sires and Wether Dams must be slick shorn to an even length from the knees and hocks up excluding the head and tail switch. No blocking will be permitted and will be grounds for refused entry into the ring.
7. This is not an ABGA sanctioned show. Therefore, it is up to the judge to determine his/her own criteria for sound mouth, teats, testicles, and pigment.
8. This show is being provided as an opportunity for those involved in the wether business to showcase those animals responsible for creating the next generation of wethers and the entries will be evaluated with this sole purpose in mind.
9. Premiums for Grand and Reserve Wether Sire and Wether Dam will be determined by the number of pre-entered entries.
10. The entry fee is \$20.00 per head for Wether Sires and Wether Dams. There will be a service charge of \$30.00 for NSF checks.

Wether Sires and Wether Dams will be weighed in at check-in time and will be divided as equally as possible into classes determined by weight.

Seniors – Those entries without all of their kid teeth regardless of weight.

NOTE: All trucks/trailers and anyone entering the fairgrounds for the goat show should enter Gate 2. The goat barn is located next to the show arena. Some barns farther away may not have the electric turned on and you may not be able to hear announcements from other barns.

## Showmanship

1. Showmanship show will start directly after all goats have been weighed. (Approximately 10 minutes after all goats have been weighed.)
2. Any junior exhibitor can enter showmanship and must show one of their own goats.
3. To enter, exhibitor must pay \$5.00 at the time of entry. Exhibitors can enter the same day as the show. All entry fee money collected will be given back in showmanship rewards the day of the show.
