

2018 MWGS SHOWMANSHIP RULES

The 2018 Showmanship series will consist of:

1. Clark County Regional Show May 5, 2018 in Springfield, Ohio
2. Fayette County May 12, 2018 in Washington Court House, Ohio
3. Miami County Classic May 19, 2018 in Troy, Ohio
4. Madison County June 9, 2018 in Springfield, Ohio
5. Ross County June 23, 2018 in Chillicothe, Ohio
6. Champaign County June 30, 2018 in Urbana, Ohio

Final - Ohio State Fair Junior Wether Show July 21st, 2018 in Columbus, OH

Please Note: Showmanship Points in 2018 will NOT include the Ohio State Fair. Showmanship is by each age at the Ohio State Fair and due to this, there will be no division winners at the Ohio State Fair which means points can't be included. However, we will award winners of each division at the Ohio State Fair after the market wether show based off the points accumulated in the first 6 shows in the series.

Ohio State Fair Junior Wether Show July 21st, 2018 in Columbus, Ohio (not included in Showmanship points)

By becoming a member, you are automatically enrolled into accumulating points earned in showmanship. Becoming a member enrolls you in both the Showmanship and Wether Series point program.

Each of the 6 series shows will include showmanship directly following weigh-in and the cost of entry is \$5.00 at each show. All entry fee money collected will be given back in showmanship rewards the day of the show.

Exhibitors **MUST** show their own animal registered in their name. No bucks will be shown in showmanship. Exhibitors can show wethers and wether dams, but must show an animal that is registered as their animal on the day of the show. No farm name or family nominations will be accepted.

Prizes for the top five in each division will be awarded at the end of the year at the Ohio State Fair after the conclusion of the Wether show.

Prizes will be awarded at each show in the series (excluding Ohio State Fair) for the top 5 winners in each division. Prizes for the top 5 in each division will be provided by each individual show and may vary depending on the show.

Showmanship Divisions (Age as of January 1, 2018)

Junior 10 & under

Intermediate 11-13

Senior 14-18

Points will be assigned as follows:

20 points for 1st

18 points for 2nd

16 points for 3rd

14 points for 4th

12 points for 5th

10 points for 6th

8 points for 7th

6 points for 8th

4 points for 9th

2 points for 10th and beyond

Participation is not limited to Ohio youth only. Any youth may participate and accumulate points in the series. However, an exhibitor must be a member of the series in order to accumulate points.

The coordinators of each individual show reserve the right to refuse entry into the show to any animal that exhibits

a transmissible disease, fungus, etc.; or to any individual or family not acting in an appropriate manner as deemed by the show committee without refunding any monies.

Ethical fitting practices must be observed at all times.

Tiebreakers

The series coordinators reserve the right to declare a tie between multiple participants.
